### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR ALL STUDENTS**

- must fit in your school locker
- 2 glue sticks (no liquid glue)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 fine-point black Sharpie marker
- 1 ruler
- 1 roll of masking tape

- 1" 3-ring binder (separate from other subjects)
- 3 pocket folders in binder
